



## INCENTIVE PROGRAM

### SUMMARY:

Participation from our extra-curricular programs at Conestoga Valley is necessary in order to fund the various projects the Buckskin Boosters sponsor each year. This participation is also crucial for future grant considerations. All extracurricular organizations have the opportunity to assist the Buckskin Activities Alliance (BAA) in fundraising, which includes donations to our various fundraisers, participation as a paying member, and volunteering time during events that are organized by the BAA.

The BAA's Incentive Program will enable each organization to accrue points by helping the BAA during their annual fundraisers. While accruing points for the BAA is not mandatory, it is a critical aspect of our decision-making process. All of our organizations can submit projects each year, however the amount of points that are accumulated by each organization will be a fundamental determining factor for approval of said projects.

### WAYS TO ACHIEVE POINTS:

#### **1 Point will be allocated for each of the following:**

- Donation of each hour of time to BAA fundraisers and organized events.  
(CV Back to School Night @ The Barnstormers, CV Craft Show, Hempfield Fall Soccer Classic, CV vs. Wizards Basketball Game, Elimination Dinner, CV Relay for Life)
- Attending a BAA monthly meetings as board member or guest
- Each \$100.00 donation to the BAA (includes donations for auctions, gift baskets for elimination dinner, etc.)

### RESPONSIBILITIES OF EXTRACURRICULAR ORGANIZATIONS FOR PROJECT CONSIDERATION

- Accrue points during the current school year
- Contact BAA's President after completion of each event, stating type of participation
- Submit project applications to Athletic Director for consideration by the BAA
- Present their project applications to the BAA, if requested
