

Fritz Reopening Plan

7.29.2020



Classroom families

- Students grouped by homeroom
- Schedules, hallway passage, recess, and specials are all adjusted so that student exposure to other children is greatly minimized

Arrival

- Car Rider-encouraged
 - Move drop off to back entrance-two lanes at parking lot for additional traffic
 - Doors open @ 8:30am
 - Students enter gym upon arrival using social distancing
 - Breakfast kiosk in the gym (social distanced tables are available)
 - Students dismissed at 8:42 to class
- K entrance--grades K, 5, and 6
 - Buses dismissed one at a time; breakfast eaters enter building @ 8:40 am
 - Breakfast Kiosk in K lobby
 - Students go to HR immediately upon getting breakfast.
 - Non-breakfast eaters dismissed from buses starting @ 8:45 am
- Main Entrance--grades 1, 2,3, and 4
 - Buses dismissed one at a time; breakfast eaters enter building @8:40 am
 - Breakfast Kiosk--main lobby
 - Students go to HR immediately upon getting breakfast.
 - Non-breakfast eaters dismissed from buses starting @ 8:45 am
- Other considerations
 - 2 additional buses added to Fritz to reduce seating to 2 to a seat if needed
 - Buses will be loaded from back to front
 - Masks are required on the buses
 - Families will be seated together
 - 9:00 am doors close; students in classrooms
 - Staff stationed at each lobby area to help direct and guide students along
 - Breakfast options will be grab-and-go, minimal lines

Dismissal

- Car riders dismissed at 3:15 --two lanes starting in parking lot
 - Carpooling is encouraged
 - May do second wave of car rider at 3:25 if needed
 - Additional staff will support
- Walkers dismissed at 3:15
- Call buses as they arrive after 3:25
 - K exit--K,5,6
 - Main exit 1,3,4
 - 2nd grade use the door at end of their hallway
 - Teachers stationed around school
 - K lobby
 - Main lobby
 - Car rider

Masks

- All students and staff are required to wear masks/face shields when social distancing is not possible per the Governor's order
- If a student is unable to wear a mask or face shield due to a medical condition, a meeting to review the information will occur to determine appropriate accommodations. Please contact Principal Trasborg.
- Bus--drivers will hand out disposable masks if needed so students can board the bus
- Mask/Face Shield Breaks (whenever students are socially distant)
 - Classroom--when working independently and social distancing 6ft.
 - Gym--when social distancing 6 ft.
 - Recess--when social distancing 6 ft.

Hallways

- Avoid classes passing each other
- All water fountains will be "turned off"
 - Student bring water bottles with NAME
 - Dixie cups may be used in classrooms at sinks for water
- Hand Sanitizers- outside classrooms and in hallways

Classrooms

- Students are grouped in HRs-self-contained, heterogeneous grouped
 - Two person teams may consider AB schedule (ELA one day, Math/Science/Social Studies the second day)
 - HR teachers will move if needed during the day
 - IF students move, student areas will be cleaned using approved CDC products between usage

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- All students will be 1-1 with computers
 - K-4 iPads
 - 5-6 Laptops
- IEP and intervention groups are being grouped together in HRs to avoid breaking the bubble of the classroom family
- A Fritz staff member will cover classes in the event that a substitute cannot be secured.
 - Substitute service has an increased amount of substitutes available due to higher unemployment
- Room Set-up
 - Furniture arrangement provides social distancing to maximum degree possible
 - Students facing the same way or staggered
 - Increased ventilation, doors/windows open
 - Classes may be offered outside
 - Recess
 - 4 recess locations - playground, macadam, and two areas at K hill allows for separate homerooms to enjoy outside
 - Field Trips—Not this year
- SPECIALS
 - Students will go to specials for 45 days--a Marking Period, and then rotate
 - CDC approved cleaning protocol between classes
 - Handwashing when leaving or returning from classroom
 - Individual material kits for special teachers (ex. individual music kits)
 - Group work/activities are permitted following safety protocols including wearing a mask and sanitation of materials before another group use them; when possible, create table family groups, and they can travel to centers together
 - Music
 - Singing outside, humming, no recorders
 - No ensembles--lessons only
 - Possible virtual concert
 - Using recommendations from Music Educators
 - Art
 - Individual materials kits
 - Tables will be sanitized between classes
 - Library
 - Students will have library class for 45 days
 - Students will be able to check out books using online check out system or book carts all year
 - Books will be sanitized for 48-72 hours depending on the cover material upon return and before recirculation
 - Phys. Ed

- Phys. Ed. will be outside as much as possible
- No equipment will be used for first 6 weeks
- Students will be engaging in 6 ft. socially distanced activities to provide a safe space for mask breaks

Cafeteria

- Cafeteria and auxiliary cafe in gym--kiosks for quick grab-and-go (no lines)
 - One grade level per location
 - Students seated by homerooms
 - Minimal lines with social distancing as needed
 - Begin with cold grab-and-go and will introduce hot lunch after routine is established
- Additional seating provided for social distanced eating
 - Currently have 20 tables--adding 20= 40+ tables total
- Tables spread out and kids staggered with assigned seats
- Peanut Allergy tables in both places
- Grade 2, 6,4, K in Cafe
- Grade 3,5,1 in Gym

Cleaning plan and ventilation

- Cleaning
 - School Day Plan—high touch areas multiple times per day (handles, light switches, faucets)
 - Additional custodian added to day shift
 - Overnight Deep cleaning- (buses, chairs, tables,bathrooms,floors, etc.)
 - CDC approved chemicals will be used
 - Frequent Hand washing preferred over hand sanitizer when possible

Ventilation

- Making sure there is good ventilation using outside air
- Pulling outside air into the building
- Different filter for building ventilation systems
- System will run 24/7 to reduce humidity and encourage air flow

Health Protocols

- Nurse
 - Nurse suite adding separate Isolation Room

- Desk out in hall for med check
- Individual health kits in rooms
- Nurse "House Calls" to classrooms (headaches, belly aches)
- Families and staff should monitor their health and stay home if they have a temperature or Covid-19 symptoms
 - Attendance policies are being updated to provide families with the flexibility to keep students home as needed for illnesses
- Staff and students should not come to school, and should notify school officials, if they:
 - become sick with COVID-19 symptoms
 - test positive for COVID-19
 - are exposed (less than 6 feet for more than 15 continuous minutes) to someone with COVID-19 symptoms or to someone with a confirmed or positive case of COVID-19
- If it is known that any student or staff member within a school community becomes ill or has been exposed to an individual confirmed positive for COVID-19, they will be immediately sent home and required to quarantine as appropriate.

Visitors

- Parents with questions are encouraged to call or email rather than coming to the Fritz office.
- Via Volunteers are permitted with office permission but may have no contact with students and may not be in classrooms
- Outside student services will pull students from classes for small groups as needed
- No parents at lunch or volunteering in the classroom at this time
- Student teachers, agency interventionists, and essential personnel will be permitted in the building
- ZOOM IEP meetings-- yes
- PTO
 - Fundraisers following social distancing protocols may occur with everything happening outside of the school
 - School will not be a meeting place for PTO
