



SENIOR ATHLETIC AWARDS 2022-2023

GEORGE M. LEFEVER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

This scholarship was established to commemorate and honor the life of George M. Lefever, 1988 CV graduate. School recipients must be graduating soccer players, they must exhibit characteristics of sportsmanship, leadership and integrity, and they must have participated in Conestoga Valley Youth Soccer as a player, coach, and/or referee. The selections are made by the CVYSC board.

CV GIRLS SOCCER BOOSTER CLUB SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship is given to the senior soccer player who has distinguished herself through academic achievement, leadership, service to others, character and teamwork as proven through an application process. The CVHS Girls Soccer Booster Club Scholarship winner is selected by a committee comprised of the soccer coaches and two parent booster club officers.

WENDELL METZLER YOUTH FOOTBALL SCHOLARSHIP

The Wendell Metzler Youth Football Scholarship is awarded each year to a qualified, college-bound senior to honor Wendell in all he has contributed to the Youth Football Program and the High School Boosters Program. The scholarship recipient must have participated throughout the Youth Football Program and the High School Football Program. This scholarship is selected by the CVYFCA's board.

CONESTOGA VALLEY YOUTH BOYS BASKETBALL SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

This scholarship is given to a graduating, varsity basketball senior pursuing a post-secondary education; a participant of the youth basketball program who gave back to the program as a volunteer.

CV YOUTH GIRLS BASKETBALL SCHOLARSHIP

The Youth Girls Basketball Scholarship is presented to a graduating member of the CV girls high school basketball program. The recipient emerged from the CV youth program, contributed significantly to the school program, and has donated time back to the youth program. The selections are made by the CV Youth Basketball Association.

CV SUMMER SWIM TEAM SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship is given to a senior swimmer(s) who has participated in both the CVSST and CVHS swim team for at least two years and plans to pursue post-graduate education. The recipient(s) demonstrates good character, leadership, and moral standards. He/she must have average or better academic standing and scholastic ability. He/she must exhibit good sportsmanship and involvement in school and community activities.

CV YOUTH SOFTBALL SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship is given to a senior softball player who has participated in both the CVYS program and CVHS Softball program for a minimum of three years and plans to pursue post-graduate education. The applicant must have a GPA of 3.0 or higher, have evidence of strong school and community leadership in addition to a letter of recommendation from a teacher or coach, a completed essay, and is in good standing with the CVHS Softball program.

CVYS BRAD CLAEYSSSEN SCHOLARSHIP

Brad Claeysen was a coach and board member in the CV Youth Softball program who passed away in October of 2022. He coached many past and present CV High School softball players. Brad is remembered as a coach for his dedication, positivity, and love for the game and his players. This scholarship is presented for one year only in Brad's memory, given to exceptional student-athletes who have participated in both the CVYS program and CVHS softball program for a minimum of three years and who also played on Brad's 14U CV Youth LANCO Championship Team. Other qualifications are the same as the CV Youth Softball Scholarship.

CV YOUTH BASEBALL SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship is given to two graduating seniors with at least three years of experience in the CV youth baseball program pursuing a post-secondary education. The criteria for this scholarship are largely academic based and the recipients must also exhibit strong leadership and teamwork skills. The CVBA is proud to offer assistance to our graduating seniors and we wish the entire graduating class good luck in the future.

CV YOUTH BOYS LACROSSE SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship award goes to a senior lacrosse player that met the following prerequisites: participated in CV youth lacrosse; exemplified Conestoga Valley values on and off the field; a high school varsity letterwinner; pursuing a post-secondary education. This player is selected with help from the high school coaching staff.



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TYLER ZOOK MEMORIAL ATHLETIC AWARD

The Tyler Zook Memorial Athletic Award is given to a senior football player who demonstrates the positive attributes that Tyler displayed in his life. It will be given to someone who demonstrates drive and discipline on the football field, as well as someone who is a genuine friend and accepting of their peers. Qualifications include: must have played four years of tackle football (can be combined youth, junior high, and senior high, with at least one year at the Senior High Varsity level); must be a current graduating senior; must submit an application. No post-secondary education plans required.

FACKLER/HOWER SPORTSMANSHIP AWARDS (PIAA DISTRICT 3)

The Fackler-Hower Sportsmanship medals are awarded by District III to one senior female and one senior male student-athlete. The winners are selected for demonstrating the most sportsmanship and citizenship-like qualities throughout the year.

E. JERRY BROOKS ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE AWARD (PIAA DISTRICT 3)

The E. Jerry Brooks Academic Excellence Medals are awarded to student-athletes who have a minimum GPA of 3.8, participated in at least two varsity sports their senior year, earned a minimum of three varsity letters during their high school career, possess good citizenship and sportsmanship, and are recommended by the school's coaches and athletic director.

LANCASTER-LEBANON LEAGUE A. LANDIS BRACKBILL SCHOLAR-ATHLETE NOMINEES

The Lancaster-Lebanon League A. Landis Brackbill Scholar Athlete Award is given annually by the Brackbill family to honor the top female and male student-athletes in the L-L League in memory of A. Landis Brackbill, the first executive director of the Lancaster-Lebanon League. To be considered as a nominee, the student-athlete must be a senior with a 3.5 GPA or higher and have played in 75 percent of varsity contests in two or more sports during the candidates' senior year. The Brackbill committee considers career athletic performance, career academic performance and leadership/community service when choosing finalists for this award.

CV SCHOLAR-ATHLETE AWARDS

Student-Athletes must have:

- a cumulative GPA of 3.5 or higher as of the end of the 3rd marking period of senior year.
- participated and completed one CV sport season during their senior year.

Receipt of a Varsity letter is not a requirement for this award.

CV BUCKSKIN ATHLETIC AWARDS

Student-Athletes must have:

- earned a Varsity letter in more than one sport during their senior year OR,
- earned more than one Varsity letter in one CV sport in four years, with one of those letters earned during their senior year.

FOUR-YEAR, THREE-SPORT STUDENT-ATHLETE RECOGNITION

Scholarships awarded by Vitality Vending

Scholarships are given by Vitality Vending to senior athletes who have played the same three sports on the high school level for four years in grades 9-12.

DISTINGUISHED ATHLETE AWARD

Distinguished Athlete Awards are given to the student-athletes who have been named an All-State or All-American player in a sport during their high school career.
