Options for Students

Advanced Placement

- Advanced Placement Program
- Offers high school students the opportunity to receive university credit for their work during high school.
- A student must pass the exam to earn the college credit. AP classes are taught by Conestoga Valley HS teachers at CVHS.

College in the High School

- Opportunity to earn "dual credit" (high school and college credit for the same course).
- Taught at the high school by high school teachers and may be considered to be part of a degree or certificate program.
- Tuition costs vary among college/universities. Most schools offer a reduced tuition rate from free up to 70% off normal rate.
- Textbooks and fees are the student's responsibility.

Options for Students

Dual Enrollment

- Program that allows high school students to enroll in college courses and earn college credit prior to high school graduation.
- Many college credits earned through dual enrollment can be transferred to other colleges or universities.
- Tuition costs vary among college/universities. Most schools offer a reduced tuition rate from free up to 70% off normal rate.
- Textbooks and fees are the student's responsibility.

Dual Enrollment Eligibility

- Juniors and Seniors
- 3.0 GPA or higher
- On track for graduation
- Good attendance
- Reliable transportation
- Ability to handle the rigor of college courses

Application Process

- Placement Tests vary per school
- PSAT/SAT or PLAN/ACT scores (must send)
- Complete partnering school applications
- Complete CV Dual Enrollment Application
- All costs are covered by student/family paid to partnering school
- Payment and admission deadlines vary per school, please check CV Dual Enrollment site

Scheduling

- Up to 9 courses per semester
 - Max of 12 weighted credits per high school career.
- Courses are part of student schedule
- Student will earn 1 high school credit for each college course
- Counselors work to blend the two schedules
 - May not know schedule until August

Weighting and Class Rank

Weighting of Courses

- Dual Enrollment 1.4
- AP/CHS 1.3
- Honors 1.2
- Traditional 1.0
- Letter grade provided to high school on college transcript is what is reported on high school transcript
- If needed, grades from college will be adapted and calculated for the high school transcript
